

Assistant Professor, Associate Professor, Professor Positions in KTÜ Department Software Engineering

KTÜ, founded in 1955, is one of oldest technical universities in Türkiye and recently has been awarded with a "Research University" title. The department of Software Engineering, on the other, is one of the very recent additions to the School of Engineering of KTÜ with 12 departments.

We are looking for energetic and enthusiastic as well as qualified persons with Ph.D degree in Computer Science, and/or Computer Engineering, Software Engineering, Data Science or closely related fields.

The appointee will be required to

a) Undertake teaching duties in undergraduate and graduate programme (in conjunction with Computer Engineering Department),

Note that the instruction language is English, and applicants are expected to meet English Proficiency requirements set by Higher Education Council of Türkiye. *

- b) Supervise undergraduate and graduate research projects and theses,
- c) Working towards to establish a graduate programme within the department,
- d) Conduct research in related areas and contribute to the efforts of both the department and KTÜ by initiating, leading or participating into the national and international collaborations and in bidding for external research grants (e.g., TÜBİTAK, Horizon Europe)

The positions are available immediately and are subjected to <u>KTÜ Appointment and Promotion Regulations</u>. The applicants are required submit their CVs including his/her publications, a cover letter, and contact information of three references to the engndean@ktu.edu.tr.



*: Non-native English speaker candidates who will be appointed as assistant professor, associate professor, or professor are expected to have a minimum score of 85** from the Foreign Language Placement Test (YDS), Higher Education Council in Interuniversity Council Foreign Language Exam (ÜDS), Public Personnel Foreign Language Proficiency Exam (KPDS), the Council of Higher Education Foreign Language Exam (YÖKDİL), or obtain an equivalent score from an international exam. Native English speakers or applicant with an undergraduate or Ph.D degree in which the instruction language is English are exempt from this condition.
