Q: Have you tried learning the local language? Can you say something in the local language?

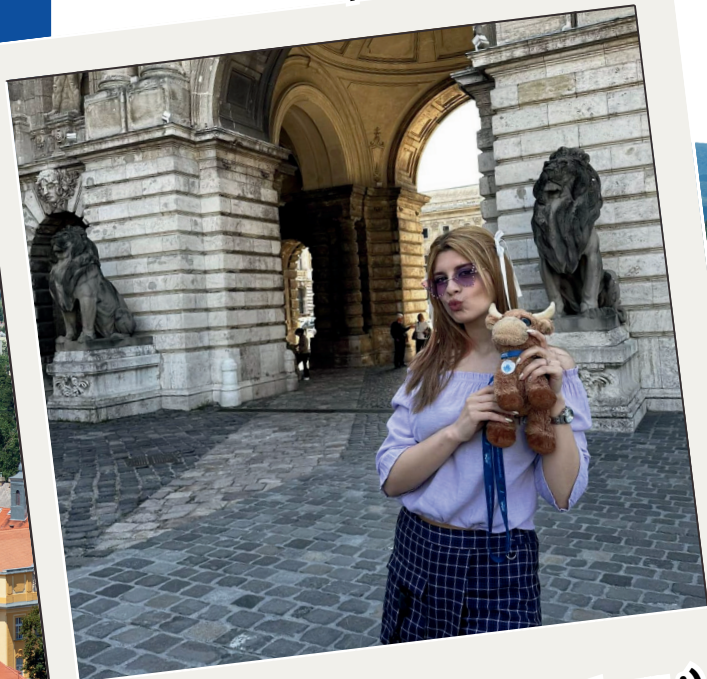
A: Yes I tried a bit! Köszönöm as Thank you, Bocsánat as Sorry.
