Preparations for Scientific and Social Activities

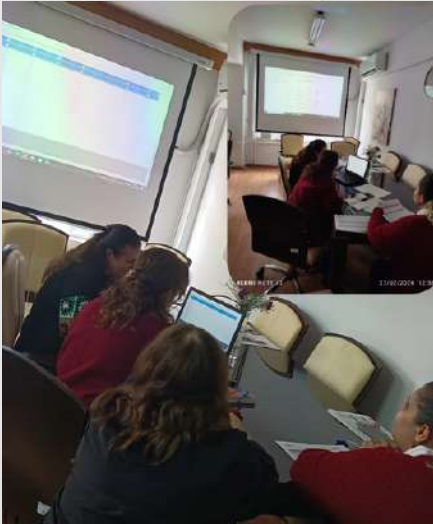

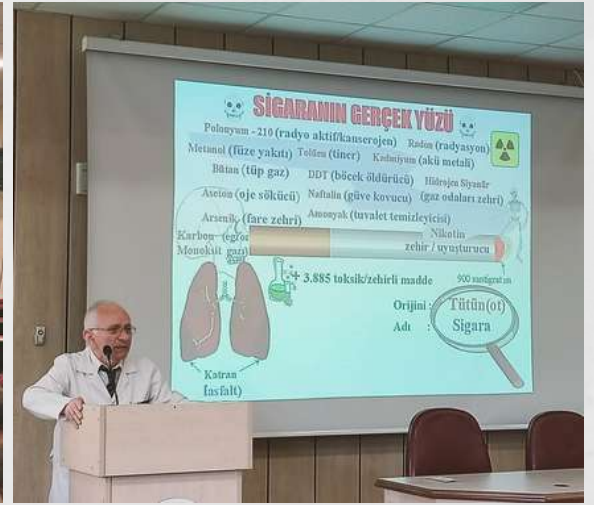
Visit in Cooperation with the KTÜ LÖSEV Benefit Community

These programs contributed significantly to improving our students' professional competencies and increasing their preparedness for working life. We thank all instructors and participants who contributed to the successful completion of these training programs.



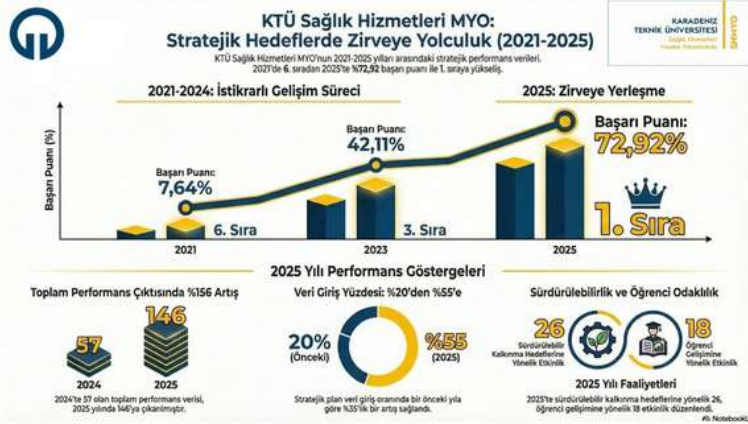
Certificate Presentation to Our Students by PARHAD

Performance Output Achievement from Our School



Karadeniz Technical University Vocational School of Health Services demonstrated a significant increase in performance between 2024 and 2025, both in its educational activities and in its quality assurance processes.

The total number of performance outputs, which was 57 in 2024, increased by 156% to 146 in 2025. During the same period, the strategic plan data entry rate increased from 20% to 55%, resulting in a significant improvement in the institution's monitoring and evaluation processes. As of 2025, our Vocational School achieved a 72.92% success score, rising to 1st place. The work carried out in line with the planned implementation of educational activities, the effective application of quality assurance processes, and a data-driven management approach has made a significant contribution to improving the quality of education at our Vocational School and strengthening the culture of quality at the institutional level.
